A Proclamation of the

Town of Micanopy

Declaring September as Hurricane Preparedness Month

Whereas: September is the peak of hurricane season when oceans are the most conducive to hurricane formation; and

Whereas: Hurricane Preparedness Month spreads awareness of the dangers of hurricanes and their capability to cause serious damage to homes, businesses, and the Town; and

Whereas: the Town desires to enhance Micanopy's resilience by safeguarding lives, protecting property, and mitigating storm impacts; and

Whereas: the Town of Micanopy encourages citizens, families, and businesses to take important steps to stay current about the latest weather developments and make advance preparation for hurricanes and the high winds, downed trees, and possible tornadoes of a hurricane, including signing up for emergency alerts, creating a disaster plan, building an emergency supply kit, preparing homes and businesses, and familiarizing yourself with the location of County emergency shelters; and

Whereas: we believe that hurricane preparedness is everyone's responsibility and that community effort is needed to effectively prepare for, mitigate against, respond to, and recover from a hurricane disaster;

Now, therefore, I, Timothy Alvin Parker, Mayor of the Town of Micanopy, so proclaim the month of September as:

Hurricane Preparedness Month

and I urge all residents of the Town of Micanopy to prepare in advance for the hurricane season.
